

Felted Wine Glass Coasters

Crocheted and felted wine glass coasters. Make them in different colors to keep track of your drinks. A great little project for your scraps of wool. Make four, wrap with ribbon and include it the next time you give a bottle of wine - makes a great gift with a personal touch.



Directions

Ch 2.

Row 1: Work 6 hdc into second ch from hook. Mark first st with st marker.

Row 2: Work 2 hdc into each st from previous round. Continue to move marker to indicate first st of each round.

Row 3: * Work 2 hdc into next st from previous round and 1 hdc into next st.** Repeat from * to ** to the end of round.

Row 4: * Work 2 hdc into next st from previous round and 1 hdc into each of the next 2 st.** Repeat from * to ** to the end of round.

Edging

Row 5: Join trim color and work 1 RSC into each st through the end. Sl st to first st of round to join. Ch 15, sk 17 st, and join to st 18 from previous round. Sl st in the next st, ch 15, and join to st 36 from previous round.

Bind off and weave in ends. Felt and block to diameter of wine glass base.

Finished Size

Felts to size

Yarn

Worsted weight wool

Hook

Size K (6.5 mm) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge

Gauge

11 hdc and 8 rows = 4"

Check your gauge before you begin

Special Stitches

rsc (reverse single crochet): Insert hook into the next st to the right, yarn over hook and pull through a loop (2 loops on hook), yarn over hook and draw through two remaining loops.
